



The Medical Expenditure Panel Survey (MEPS), which began in 1996, is a national longitudinal panel study of healthcare use and costs sponsored by the Agency for Healthcare Research and Quality (AHRQ), part of the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services.

Households are interviewed five times over the course of 2½ years by MEPS field interviewers using Westat-provided laptops and iPhones to conduct in-person, computer-assisted personal interviews (CAPI) or computer-assisted video interviews (CAVI). The MEPS panel study design means that each year a new panel of households is added to the sample and that MEPS interviewers have work throughout most of the year.
