

Migrant and Seasonal Head Start (MSHS)

Do you enjoy working with children and their parents? Are you bilingual (English/Spanish)? Are you available to travel, typically for 1 – 2 weeks at a time? If so, then consider applying to the Migrant and Seasonal Head Start (MSHS) study!

We are currently seeking detail-oriented individuals to work as part of a Data Collection Team onsite at MSHS centers as 1) Team Leaders/Interviewers, 2) Interviewers/Assessors, and 3) Interviewers/Observers on the MSHS, an important study providing comprehensive information about the characteristics and experiences of children and families enrolled in MSHS.

The primary roles of the Team Leaders/Interviewers will be to work with the centers' designated Onsite Coordinators to schedule the data collection activities, obtain parental informed consent, and obtain teacher and assistant teacher survey and child ratings completion. Team Leaders will manage the data collection team, conduct in-person parent interviews, return all completed study instrument data regularly, and regularly complete and submit administrative paperwork. Interviewers/Assessors will conduct in-person child assessments and parent interviews. Interviewers/Observers will conduct in-person parent interviews and classroom observations. Child assessments and classroom observations will be conducted at centers, and parent interviews will be conducted at the centers or where the family lives or at another public locale.
