Energy Consumption Survey

The Commercial Buildings Energy Consumption Survey (CBECS), conducted by the Energy Information Administration (EIA) of the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE), is the nation's only comprehensive survey of commercial buildings. Data is collected through interviews with building owners and managers, and with energy suppliers, to estimate the characteristics and energy-use patterns of all types of commercial buildings in the U.S. The information provided by CBECS is essential for updating energy policies and goals; setting benchmarks for conservation programs, building design, and building code development; and tracking the impact of new technologies and construction practices on energy consumption and efficiency.

Interviews are conducted with respondents at sampled commercial buildings in-person or via an online questionnaire self-administered by the respondent. Most positions require work during regular business hours.
