

HANDLS Sleep Study

The Healthy Aging in Neighborhoods of Diversity across the Life Span (HANDLS) Sleep Study is funded by the National Institute on Aging (NIA) through a grant to Clemson University that looks at how sleep may impact health and well-being.

The primary role of the phlebotomist will be to schedule the blood collection visits in coordination with the Field Interviewers within a specific time period. The Phlebotomist will be responsible for administering written informed consent for the study to the study participant and completing the blood collection protocol. The phlebotomist will also transport the blood samples to the collaborating research laboratory in Baltimore.

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
