

FoodAPS-2 - National Food Study Pilot

Westat is currently seeking motivated individuals with a commitment to excellence to collect data for an important study, the National Food Study Pilot (NFS), also known as FoodAPS-2.

The FoodAPS-2 will ask households to provide information on food items acquired over a 7-day period. The main objective is to test households' ability to use a smartphone app to report information such as food item descriptions, quantities and prices, where the food is acquired, and how they paid for them. The FoodAPS field interviewer will locate, obtain cooperation, screen, and interview selected respondents in their homes. Interviewers will use iPhones to complete all data collection activities. Once a household is eligible, they will play videos to train households to use smartphones or laptops to report data.
