

NAEP 2021 is Hiring!

The National Assessment of Educational Progress, also known as NAEP or The Nation's Report Card, is sponsored by the National Center for Education Statistics, which is part of the U.S. Department of Education.

We are now accepting new applications for NAEP 2021 data collection field positions. Interested individuals should select the “Search for Positions and Apply Now” button on <https://fig.westat.com/>, search for positions using the keyword “NAEP,” and enter their state.

NAEP involves conducting assessment sessions with 4th- and 8th-grade students in participating schools across the country. Most NAEP assessments last approximately 120 minutes. Sessions vary in size according to school guidelines. NAEP field staff usually work in teams.

NAEP field staff receive paid training for all job responsibilities, paid time and mileage reimbursement for local driving to and from schools, weekly paychecks (direct deposit available), and opportunities for advancement based on performance.

Protecting the health and safety of our employees and survey participants is a top priority for Westat. Based on recommendations from the CDC and other public health authorities, we require staff to protect and monitor their health while working on their assignment, which may include the use of personal protective equipment (PPE), regular testing for COVID-19, or other screening activities.

Qualified applicants should:

- Be a U.S. citizen;
- Be fluent in English (persons speaking fluent English and Spanish are encouraged to apply);
- Be comfortable working with technology;
- Be detail-oriented;
- Have the ability to work effectively on a diverse team;
- Be able to work with students in a classroom setting;
- Have the ability to lift a case weighing 20 pounds into and out of cars, with or without a reasonable accommodation;
- Have a valid (current) driver's license that is not under suspension and have regular access to reliable transportation to travel to and from schools;

- Be available for all required online training and an in-person meeting with your team before assessments begin; and
- Be available to work during the day between January 25 and March 12, 2021. The data collection window may be extended due to weather or other delays.
